SUBJECT: Discharge of Zinc and Silver into the Sanitary
Sewer System

Zinc and silver concentrations are being detected in the sanitary sewer system in excess of allowable limits. High levels were detected in weekly samples collected February 26 thru March 30, 1990. High levels were again detected the week of April 9--13, 1990.

Discharge of zinc and silver into the sanitary sewer system must cease immediately. Facility Safety Heads, Facility Coordinators and Contract Safety Representatives are requested to complete the certification form below and return to John Lee, Mail Stop 429 by close of business April 27, 1990.

A sanitary sewer sampling program has been initiated to guarantee the accuracy of the responses.
