SUBJECT: Disposal of Photographic Chemicals

Disposal of photographic chemicals into the sanitary sewer system without specific authorization from the Safety Engineering Branch is prohibited.

Pollution concentrations allowable in the sanitary sewer system are established for LaRC by the Hampton Roads Sanitation District under a permit system. No disposals are allowed except under this permit. Photographic chemical disposals must be accurately documented. A program of routine sampling and analyses to verify permit limits are not exceeded is required. Silver recovery units may not provide sufficient recovery efficiency to insure permit compliance.

Disposal of photographic chemicals into the storm sewer is never permissible.

Facility Safety Heads and Facility Coordinators are requested to review areas of responsibility and identify operations using photographic chemicals.
