



Total Cases (civil servant/contractor) [] = Number of new occurrences

OSHA Recordable Cases = Fatalities, Lost Time, Incidents, and Restricted Work Incidents.
Incidents = Cases in which more than first aid treatment is required, but less than 8 hours of time is lost.
Restricted Work Incidents = Cases requiring first aid treatment, resulting in light duty restrictions.

Injury/Mishap Information

- The Center has been **25** days **without** a Civil Servant or Contractor **Lost Time Injury. (Record 74 days).**
- **OSHA Recordable Incidents**
 - On September 23, 2004, a Swales employee sustained a left eye irritation from a particle of dust while moving between offices in a facility. A prescription-strength medication was administered, making the case an OSHA Recordable Incident.
 - On October 5, 2004, a COD employee sustained a left knee strain while assembling shelving. The employee stepped down from one level of the shelving and slipped. A prescription-strength medication was administered.



Physical Lifting Requirements - Back and muscular injuries are the result of a large number accidents at the Center; therefore, Center personnel are reminded that the LaRC individual person lifting standard is less than 40 lbs., depending on the individual's capabilities. When lifting loads greater than your individual capability, seek assistance or use a mechanical device, such as a pallet jack or hand truck to move the load.
