


# LaRC SAFETY HIGHLIGHTS

OSHA Recordable Cases = Fatalities, Lost Time and Incidents  
Incidents = Non first aid medical cases which have less than 8 hours lost time



- The Center has been **128** days **without** a Civil Servant **Lost Time Injury** (Record 251 days).

- No first aid cases involving civil servants were reported during the past week.



- **Safety Information** - When a facility fire alarm sounds, immediately exit the facility and congregate in a common area a safe distance from the facility and account for all personnel. Immediately notify emergency response personnel if someone is believed to still be in the facility.
