OSHA Recordable Cases = Fatalities, Lost Time and Incidents
Incidents = Non first aid medical cases which have less than 8 hours lost time



Injury/Mishap Information

- The Center has been **42** days **without** a Civil Servant **Lost Time Injury**. (Record 251 days)
- No first aid cases involving civil servants were reported.



Physical Collision Hazards - Collision hazards are caused by low overheads or objects that protrude into work areas and passageways. Examples of collision hazards are piping, wiring conduits, and other structural components. These hazards should be removed, cushioned, and/or identified with caution tape, when possible, to eliminate the possibility of employees injuring themselves.
