

Incidents = Non first aid medical cases which have less than 8 hours lost time


Injury/Mishap Information

- The Center has been **184** days **without** a Civil Servant **Lost Time Injury** (Record 251 days).
- The following first aid cases involving civil servants were reported.
 - An Office of Procurement employee slipped in an icy parking lot, sustaining abrasions to the hands and legs.
 - An Aerodynamics, Aerothermodynamics and Acoustics Competency (AAAC) employee bumped his head on the edge of a model sustaining a laceration.
 - An AAAC employee removing an adhesive sanding disc from a sander, lost balance and fell backwards, sustaining a sprain and injuring the right hand.
 - An AAAC employee walked off the edge of a sidewalk, while speaking to someone, and twisted the right ankle and left knee.
 - An Aerospace Systems Concepts and Analysis Competency employee sustained a laceration to a finger by pulling on the corner of the desk while sitting in the chair.
 - A Systems Engineering Competency employee bumped his head, while working in a simulator, sustaining a scalp laceration.
 - An Office of External Affairs employee sustained a soft tissue injury to the right foot when a box fell from a stack when opening a file drawer.



Safety Information
