Incidents = Non first aid medical cases which have less than 8 hours lost time

## Injury/Mishap Information



- The Center has been **35** days **without** a Civil Servant **Lost Time Injury** (Record 251 days).
- The following first aid case involving a civil servant was reported.
  - A SMC employee sustained a forehead laceration from a test panel sticking out in a walkway.



- **Safety Information** - Airworthiness and Safety Review Board - Conducts review and provides guidance for all LaRC-conducted or managed aircraft flight and drop model test operations for the purposes of: 1) approving Flight Safety Release letters, and (2) recommending airworthiness and safety requirements and information for flight operations personnel in accordance with LAPG 1710.9 "Flight Operations Guide and Manual," and LAPG 1710.14 "Aviation Safety."
