Incidents = Non first aid medical cases which have less than 8 hours lost time

## Injury/Mishap Information

- The Center has been **42** days **without** a Civil Servant **Lost Time Injury** (Record 251 days).
- The following first aid cases involving civil servants were reported:
  - A SEC employee sustained a finger laceration from a lathe tool bit.
  - An Office of Education employee pinched a finger on a toilet flush handle joint.
  - A SEC employee sustained a scalp laceration, after striking forehead on router table cutting tool, while changing a part to be machined.
  - An AAAC employee sustained a small finger laceration from a splinter while moving a wooden box.
  - A SEC employee slipped on an icy walkway, sustaining a lumbar back strain.



- **Safety Information** - Electrical Systems Committee - Reviews and provides guidance on grounding systems, flight electrical power systems, and other control systems. Recommends requirements, standards, and procedures for systems designed to use, store, confine, or distribute significant levels of electrical energy. Also investigates and recommends corrective action for major electrical system faults. Provides electrical systems information for the LAPG 1710.6, "Electrical Safety," and LAPG 1710.10, "Safety Clearance Procedures (Lockout/Tagout)."
