OSHA Recordable Cases = Fatalities, Lost Time and Incidents
Incidents = Non first aid medical cases which have less than 8 hours lost time

Injury/Mishap Information

- The Center has been **126** days **without** a Civil Servant **Lost Time Injury** (Record 251 days).
- The following first aid cases involving civil servants were reported:
 - A SEC employee bumped a knee while stepping off of an elevated machine platform and sustained a contusion. The employee was cautioned to be more aware of surroundings in the future.
 - A SEC employee using a finger to remove chips from a rotating drill, drilled a hole in the finger and sustained a puncture wound. The employee was counseled to use a brush in the future to remove chips.



- **Safety Information** - LAPD 1700.1, "Safety Program," sets forth the Langley Research Center safety program policy to ensure each employee a safe and healthful working environment that is free from unacceptable hazards, which could result in property/equipment damage, injury or loss of life.
