


LaRC SAFETY HIGHLIGHTS

FY 2000 – Civil Servants



OSHA Recordable Cases = Fatalities, Lost Time and Incidents
Incidents = Non-first aid medical cases which have less than 8 hours lost time

- The Center has been 17 days without a civil servant experiencing a Lost Time Injury (Record 251 days).
- LaRC Safety Information – Employees (civil service or contractors) who engage in work activities with potential exposure to ionizing or nonionizing radiation, hazardous materials, pyrotechnic devices or elevated work areas 25 feet or higher require specialized training.
- The following first aid case involving a civil servant was reported:
 - An Aerodynamics, Aerothermodynamics, and Acoustics Competency employee tripped while descending a stairway sustaining a left leg strain.
