

[] = Number of new occurrences

OSHA Recordable Cases = Fatalities, Lost Time, Incidents, and Restricted Work Incidents.
Incidents = Cases in which more than first aid treatment is required, but less than 8 hours of time is lost.
Restricted Work Incidents = Cases requiring first aid treatment, resulting in light duty restrictions.

Injury/Mishap Information

- The Center has been **53** days **without** a Civil Servant or Contractor **Lost Time Injury. (Record 53 days)**

- OSHA Recordable Incidents**

- An AAAC employee sustained a thermal burn to the left eye while participating in a laser test. The injury was due to a small gap between the bottom of the protective glasses and the employee's face. The employee was referred to an ophthalmologist for treatment, making this an OSHA Recordable incident.
- An OHR employee experienced right wrist discomfort due to extended computer mouse usage, diagnosed as repetitive motion syndrome. A prescription strength medication was administered making this an OSHA Recordable incident. An ergonomic evaluation has been performed.



- First Aid Cases**

- An AAAC employee sustained a left finger laceration while using a razor blade to cut a plastic control line to a model. The blade slipped striking the employee's finger.
- A PDMO employee sustained a right knee contusion from falling while descending a stairway.
- A MLB employee sustained a right eye irritation from a piece of debris while mowing the grass.
