


# LaRC SAFETY HIGHLIGHTS

Total Cases (civil servant/contractor)

[ ] = Number of new occurrences

OSHA Recordable Cases = Fatalities, Lost Time, Incidents, and Restricted Work Incidents.  
Incidents = Cases in which more than first aid treatment is required, but less than 8 hours of time is lost.  
Restricted Work Incidents = Cases requiring first aid treatment, resulting in light duty restrictions.

## Injury/Mishap Information

- The Center has been **4** days **without** a Civil Servant or Contractor **Lost Time Injury. (Record 76 days)**
- **Lost Time Accident** - On Wednesday, September 15, 2004, a Jacobs Sverdrup employee entered a confined space to change light bulbs. The employee lost footing and fell into an adjacent pit, sustaining multiple injuries. An investigation into the accident is being conducted by the Government and the contracting company.
- **First Aid Case** - A Tessada & Associates employee sustained a right shoulder contusion while moving pallets with a motorized pallet jack. The pallet jack flipped to one side, due to the loading dock platform giving way when the employee had off-loaded pallets into a truck.



**Lifting Devices** – All lifting devices, such as cranes, shop lifts, pallet jacks, and associated hardware shall be inspected annually. Each device shall have an affixed tag indicating the date of the last inspection. Lifting devices that are found to be out of inspection should immediately be reported to the Facility Coordinator or Facility Safety Head of the facility where the device is located.
